

Vermont State University Lyndon Campus is located in Vermont's beautiful Northeast Kingdom on a plateau that affords a spectacular view of Burke Mountain and the Passumpsic Valley. Many other scenic attractions such as Lake Willoughby and Mt. Washington with its world-famous cog railway are within a 90-minute drive. The wooded area surrounding the campus offers trails for leisurely hikes. Public beaches, horseback riding, and a golf course are within easy driving distance.

Participants and faculty are housed in private rooms in modern dormitories with lounges suitable for ensemble playing, several with pianos. Meals are served cafeteria style in the college's dining hall, and the college library and athletic facilities, including tennis courts and an all-weather swimming pool, are open to all participants.

Vermont Music and Arts Center is a workshop for serious amateur musicians seeking an informal and congenial atmosphere in which to play chamber music - to "take a vacation with music." VMAC differs from most workshops. Our faculty, professional musicians with extensive chamber music experience, often play with us, coaching from within the group, inspiring us by their example.

In addition, unlike many other workshops with assigned groups and assigned pieces, we choose our own repertoire from the suggested "Works of the Week," from music we bring with us, or from VMAC's extensive library of over 1,000 chamber works.

Our Friday night concerts by those participants who wish to perform give everyone the opportunity to enjoy works studied during the week.

Open readings for larger ensembles, early music, choral and visual arts workshops, folk dancing, plus exciting faculty performances round out the opportunities for participants to create their own "musical vacation."

REGISTRATION

To register, complete the application form, include an application fee of \$55/person if before May 15 or \$100 after, and mail to the address on the form. This fee is non-refundable unless your application is not accepted. The full cost is due on or before June 15 and is non-refundable after that date except for medical reasons as judged by the registrar. A \$250 administrative fee will be withheld in such cases.

The following weekly fees cover room and board, tuition (for participants), concerts, evening activities, and use of all facilities:

Single Room (in dorm with elevators): \$1575/\$1175 for guest

Check-in is on Sundays between 3 and 5pm. Check-out is Sundays by 10am.
