



The Avaloch Farm Music Institute (AFMI) provides air conditioned bedrooms in suites with bathroom facilities and a small kitchenette. Music facilities include 7 Steinway grand pianos, and multiple rehearsal and performance spaces. Three delicious meals are prepared daily by the chef and staff.

For exercise, on campus there are a fitness room as well as meadows and forests for hiking and a lake for swimming and boating. The lakes of the New Hampshire Lakes Region are within a half hour to a 90 minute drive from campus. Restaurants and shopping can be found in Concord, the state capital, 14 miles away.

Vermont Music and Arts Center, formerly of Lyndonville, VT, is a workshop for serious amateur musicians seeking an informal and congenial atmosphere in which to “take a vacation with music.” VMAC differs from most workshops. Our faculty, professional musicians with extensive chamber music experience, often play *with* us, coaching from within the group, inspiring us by their example.

In addition, unlike many other workshops with assigned groups and assigned pieces, we choose our own repertoire from the suggested "Works of the Week," from music we bring with us, or from VMAC's extensive library of over 1,000 chamber works.

Our Friday night concerts given by those participants who wish to perform give everyone the opportunity to enjoy works studied during the week.

Open readings for larger ensembles, early music, choral and visual arts workshops, folk dancing, plus exciting faculty performances round out the opportunities for participants to create their own “musical vacation.”

## REGISTRATION

To register, mail the application form with application fee of \$55 by **March 20** (\$100 after March 20) to the address on the application form. This fee is non-refundable unless your application is not accepted. **The full cost is due on or before May 1** and is refundable only for exceptional medical reasons as judged by the Managing Director. A \$250 administrative fee will be withheld. Early registration is encouraged as on-campus rooms are limited. A block of rooms has been reserved at the Holiday Inn Express in Tilton, NH for overflow. (Contact the Managing Director for details.)

The following weekly fees cover room and board, tuition (for participants), concerts, evening activities, and use of all facilities:

**Single Room:** \$1850 or \$1450 for guest  
**Shared Room:** \$1550/\$1150 **Commuter(e.g. staying at Holiday Inn):** \$800/\$400 (All prices are 20% less for the shorter Week 1)

Check-in is on Sundays (Monday for Week 1) between 3 and 5pm. Check-out is Sundays by 10am.
